

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL BINGO AND RAFFLE ORDINANCES
TO PERMIT DEAF AND BLIND PERSONS TO EMPLOY PERSONS TO ASSIST IN
MANAGEMENT AND TO REQUIRE APPLICATION TO USE THE FORM IN SECTION 18.2-340.2
OF THE CODE OF VIRGINIA FOR APPLICATION AND THE FORMS IN 18.2-340.6
FOR FINANCIAL REPORTS

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED AS FOLLOWS:

Sec. 1. The Municipal Bingo and Raffle Ordinance be amended as follows:

Except for persons employed as clerical assistants by organizations composed of or for deaf or blind persons, only bona fide members of any such organization who have been members of such organization for at least ninety days prior to such participation shall participate in the management, operation or conduct of any bingo game or raffle. Except as provided herein, no person shall receive remuneration for participating in the management, operation or conduct of any such game or raffle. Persons employed by organizations composed of or for deaf or blind persons may receive remuneration not to exceed thirty dollars per event for providing clerical assistance in the conduct of bingo games or raffles only for such organizations. Persons eighteen years of age and under who sell raffle tickets to raise funds for youth activities in which they participate may receive non-monetary incentive awards or prizes from the organization provided that organization is nonprofit. The spouse of any bona fide member or a fire fighter or rescue squad member employed by a political subdivision with which the volunteer fire fighter or rescue squad member is associated may participate in the operation and conduct of a bingo game or raffle if a bona fide member is present.

Sec. 2. Applications to Council for a permit to conduct bingo games and raffles and annual applications shall use the forms prescribed by Section 18.2-340.2 of the Code of Virginia as amended.

Sec. 3. A record of receipts and disbursements shall be filed as required by Ordinance on the forms prescribed by Section 18.2-340.6 of the Code of Virginia.
