"Home occupations" are allowed only if <u>ALL</u> of the following conditions can be met:

- 1. The home occupation must be conducted solely by one or more members of a family residing on the premises.
- 2. The home occupation must be incidental or secondary to the use of the premises for a residence.
- 3. Not more than one-half of one floor of the home shall be used for the home occupation.
- 4. The home occupation shall not require internal or external alterations to the home.
- 5. No person other than a member of the family living at the home may be employed on the premises.
- 6. NO COMMODITY MAY BE STORED OR SOLD EXCEPT FOR THOSE ITEMS <u>MADE</u> ON THE PREMISES.
- 7. There may be no outdoor displays or storage of merchandise, materials, or equipment.
- 8. There may be no display to indicate from the exterior of the dwelling that the building is being used for any purpose other than a dwelling. (A name plate or directional sign limited in area to two square feet may be used to identify the permitted home occupation).
- 9. There must be sufficient off-street parking areas in the immediate proximity to the dwelling to accommodate the residents of the premises as well as any clients to be received on the premises without any inconvenience to neighbors or blocking of street access.
- 10. THIS ESTABLISHMENT MAY NOT OFFER SERVICES TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC.
- 11. If the applicant for the proposed home occupation is not the owner of the dwelling and/or lot, a written letter from the owner of the premises stating no objections to the planned enterprise must be attached to the application.

IF ALL OF THE ABOVE CONDITIONS CAN BE MET THE PROPOSED USE MAY BE LOCATED WITHIN THE SUBJECT RESIDENCE.
