

ORDINANCE NO. 15, 1999

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WISE, VIRGINIA PROHIBITING RIDING, DRIVING, OR LEADING HORSES, PONIES, AND MULES ON ANY TOWN HIGHWAY, ROAD, STREET, SIDEWALK, OR OTHER PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY; PROVISION FOR WASTE; PENALTIES

Pursuant to Virginia Code Section 15.2-204 and 15.2-1102, **BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED** that the riding, driving, or leading of horses, ponies, and mules on any sidewalk in the Town of Wise, Virginia, is prohibited; and

Pursuant to Virginia Code Section 15.2-204 and 15.2-1102, **BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED** that the riding, driving, or leading of horses, ponies, and mules on any highway, road, street, or other public right-of-way, without provision on the animal for catching manure, in the Town of Wise, Virginia, is prohibited.

"Public right-of-way" as used in this ordinance means any area over which the public has a general privilege to travel as set forth in Virginia Code Section 15.2-2000.

The provisions of this ordinance shall not apply to any animals used in any public parade in the town of Wise, for which parade a permit has been issued.

The penalty for violation of this ordinance shall be a fine or not more than TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY (\$250.00) DOLLARS. This penalty is fixed pursuant to Virginia Code Sections 15.2-1429 and 18.2-11.
