

ORDINANCE NUMBER 2, 1995

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WISE, VIRGINIA AMENDING SECTION 138 OF THE CRIMINAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN PERTAINING TO THE ATTENDANCE OF MINORS IN POOL ROOMS AND BILLIARD ROOMS.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Wise, Virginia revised, rewrote, rearranged, and amended the general ordinances and laws of the Town of Wise on December 22, 1975:

WHEREAS, section 138 of those general ordinances and laws pertains to the attendance of minors in pool rooms and billiard rooms and the Town Council now desires to modify and amend said section 138; and notice of this amendment has been advertised in a newspaper of general circulation in the Town as provided by law:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Town Council that Section 138 of the 1975 Criminal Ordinances and laws of the Town of Wise is hereby amended and enacted as follows and all other ordinances in conflict with these provisions are hereby repealed:

SECTION 138.

No minor under the age of eighteen years of age shall frequent, play in or loiter in any public pool room or billiard room where alcoholic beverages are sold or served, not shall the proprietor of any pool room or billiard room or his agent permit any minor to frequent, play in or loiter in any place in violation of the foregoing.

Any minor, proprietor or agent violating the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a Class 3 misdemeanor.
